
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Tools Needed


9/16" Box End Wrench Torque Wrench (ft. lbs.) w/ 9/16" Socket Utility Knife Straight Edge Protective Eyewear

USER/OPERATOR SAFETY AND MAINTENANCE:


- Always route safety chains under mud flap frame, not through holes.
- Always remove mud flaps before entering automatic car wash systems.
- Do Not use mud flap frame as a step.
- Do Not hook up anything to mud flap frame.
- · Periodically check all bolts/nuts and retighten if needed.




Insert (6) 1" carriage bolts through frame and gusset (orientate gusset as shown in Figure 1), secure with lock washers and nuts.

STEP 2


Insert (2) long carriage bolts through clamp halves with flat washer, lock washer and nut.





Orientate flat surface of clamp assembly with backside of frame so nuts on long bolts face down. Attach clamps to frame with (4) short carriage bolts, flat washers, lock washers so nuts face vehicle. Leave all bolts loose for now. See page 7 for ball mounts available to order from Agri-Cover.


STEP 4



Slide ball mount through frame and clamps. Lift assembly up and insert ball mount into receiver tube. Secure with pin and clip.

NOTE: If ball mount holes do not align to allow pin to be inserted or if mud flap frame cannot be positioned to hang straight and plumb, a longer ball mount may be needed before proceeding.


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
Position frame with support flanges on bumper step (Figure 5). Important: To avoid rubbing, a gap should be left between the frame and the bumper.

STEP 6

Finger tighten short carriage bolts on clamp assembly. Next ensure frame is level with bumper, push down firmly at bumper step on top. Make sure vertical face of frame is plumb and tighten top bolts only, equally on both sides. Next tighten both long bolts to secure frame to ball mount. Finally tighten lower carriage bolts and torque all six bolts to 32 ft. lbs.




Position rubber flaps as shown (Figure 6). Orientate the side with letters to face the tires of the vehicle. Bolt rubber flaps to frame using (3) carriage bolts, flat washers, lock washers and nuts. Tighten nuts until lock washers are fully compressed.




NOTE TO INSTALLER/OPERATOR:

- May not work with some custom exhausts. An optional heat shield is also available to protect rubber flaps from hot exhaust (see page 7 for details). If exhaust lines up with holes in frame, a hole may be cut in rubber at these locations.
- 2. ALWAYS CHECK GROUND CLEARANCE OF HITCH MOUNTED MUD FLAP.
 - Suggested clearance is 5" to 7" above ground. If too low, undo hitch pin and remove mud flap assembly. Use straight edge to mark a cut line at bottom of each flap. Make trim cut along line.

Install stabilizer brackets on each side of frame using carriage bolt, flat washer, lock washer and nut (Figure 7a). Clean bumper surface with isopropyl alcohol, remove adhesive backing and adhere protective disc on bumper where vinyl caps will rest against bumper. (Note: Optimum adhesion occurs between 70-100° F). Adjust brackets until vinyl bumper caps are "snug" against vehicle bumper (Figure 7b).





TIP: If clamp assembly butts up to receiver before both bumper caps are against bumper, remove clamps and reassemble them on ball mount side of mud flap frame.
